

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **8 riders** per gender per discipline.

Pre-seeded riders do not count against the Country Quota registration limit, they don't need to be registered in the Sports Entry Platform but this riders must still complete the Anti Doping procedure in the Platform.

National Federations will receive a separate link to register pre-seeded riders.

COMPETITION FORMAT

<u>STREET</u> Open Qualifier Semis: top 20 riders from the OQ + 8 pre-seeded riders Final: top 10 riders

<u>PARK</u> Open Qualifier Semis: top 22 riders from the OQ + 10 pre-seeded riders Final: top 10 riders





SEEDING STRUCTURE

Park Men:

- the **TOP 10** qualified riders of the World Roller Games 2019 will advance directly to the Semifinal round of the competition.
- riders ranked from 11th to 24th position in the WRG will compete at the Open Qualifier. They do not count against the country quota.

Park Women:

- the **TOP 6** qualified riders of the World Roller Games 2019 will advance directly to the Semifinal round of the competition.
- riders ranked from 7th to 15th position in the WRG will compete at the Open Qualifier. They do not count against the country quota.

ENTRY FEE

For this event, there will be **no registration fee** to pay.

REGISTRATION

The registration to the event will take place through the online World Skate Sports Entry Platform. Riders must contact their National Federations of belonging to be registered for the event, as National Federations are the only ones who can access the World Skate Sports Entry Platform to register athletes.

The platform will open on July 26th at 00:00 am and will close on September 15th at 11.59 pm (CET).

Given the emergency status due to the pandemic, we invite you to register essential staff only.

PRE-SEEDED RIDERS

Pre-seeded riders (to Open Qualifier or Semifinal) don't need to be registered through the Sports Entry Platform, but each National Federation will receive a link via e-mail to register them.

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards may be granted based on criteria or lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the riders' country of origin.

Wild Cards will be issued at World Skate sole discretion.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an e-mail to <u>platform@worldskate.org</u> before September 8th at 11.59 PM CET.

LEGAL GUARDIANS /PARENTS

Given the Covid restrictions, each minor will be allowed to register up to 1 parent or legal guardian on site.

ANTI-DOPING

The anti-doping control will be carried out according to World Skate Medical Regulations and WADA Rules.

Anti-Doping forms will be required for both athletes and staff members. Same applies to preseeded riders.





Each of them shall fill out the Anti-Doping form online in the Anti-Doping section of World Skate Platform: <u>https://platform.worldskate.org/web/</u>

You can download the <u>Anti-Doping Form User Guideline</u> and read the instructions about how to complete this mandatory procedure.

Upon completion of the abovementioned procedure, National Federations will be enabled to register their respective athletes and staff members.

All athletes, including pre-seeded riders and Wild Cards- if approved- are required to upload the Anti Doping certificate in the World Skate Sports Entry Platform in order to complete their registration for the event.
